WIV16, was isolated from *Rhinolophus sinicus* bats in the Yunnan province. WIV16 has a 95% nucleotide and 97% amino acid identity to SARS-CoV-1 (Yang et al. 2016). WIV16, with a 97% amino acid similarity, can use bat, civet, and human ACE2 receptors for cell entry (Ge et al. 2913).
